

From Our Pastor

Climbing The Hill

Psalm 24:3-4 But who can ascend the hill of the Lord and who can stand in His holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart and has not lifted up his soul to an idol.

The Psalmist asks a question we should all want to know the answer to: "Who can ascend the hill of the Lord?" Wow! What a thought! He is actually saying that we can have a connection with **WHERE** God is. What does that mean? It means that God loves for us to visit His Presence and He is reminding us that it is a possibility. He is reminding us that Presence is possible. He is reminding us that God is **NOT** unreachable. He is reminding us that intimate encounters are possible. I would argue that they aren't only possible, but absolutely necessary if we truly want to represent Him on the earth to a lost and broken world.

Not only does the Psalmist tell us that ascension is doable, but he actually tells us **HOW** it's accomplished and **WHO** can go there. The ones who visit the hill of the Lord (Presence) are the ones who attempt it with "clean hands and a pure heart and have not lifted up their souls to an idol."

Let's examine these three traits of an ascender. One, we must have clean hands. I think having clean hands means that we have allowed the Holy Spirit to purify us from habitual sin. I believe that one of the basic requirements of finding Presence is that we aren't living with unrepentant sin in our lives. He further says that we should have clean hearts. While I believe clean hands represents viewable sin in our lives, I believe having clean hearts represents the hidden sins one might engage in. God doesn't just want to clean the outward man; He wants to clean the inward one as well. Finally, the Word says that we can't be a people who are lifting our souls to idols. I believe this is a direct indictment of our worship life. Worship, by definition, is us acknowledging what we give our attention to. If we only want to get rich, have a big house, build our bank account, and have power; we are probably worshipping money or prestige. On the contrary, if we want Him above every other thing in our lives, we are probably worshipping Him. An idol is anything that comes between us and Him; it's anything that we desire above Him. God is calling us to a purity of heart and a pure pursuit of the Father. If we are willing to allow Him to clean our hands, our hearts, and our pursuits; INTIMACY is possible. Let's give it a try! Climbing the hill matters.
