From Our Pastor

"We NEED Anointing!"

Luke 4:18-19 "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; ¹⁹ To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD."

In Isaiah 10:27, there is a very interesting phrase that goes like this: "And the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing." What is the yoke and what is the anointing? The yoke, in this particular scripture; was the heaviness, the oppression, and the ungodly harassment that Israel had endured for most of her history. God is promising to remove this yoke of bondage. How would He remove it? The answer to that question is simple. He said He would remove it by the anointing. How can anointing remove a bondage? To better understand the answer, we must understand what He meant by anointing. Anointing is understood to be the "place" where His Presence showed up. Most often this happens when the Holy Spirit comes to a location where rescuing is needed and necessary. Yes, even in the Old Testament, the Holy Spirit could and would show up in places to bring freedom and healing. Obviously, it wasn't as accessible as it is now since the resurrection, but it was always a possibility. The Holy Spirit always was!

Now let's skip ahead to the New Testament and take a look at what Jesus is saying in Luke 4. He is first of all acknowledging that the anointing is on Himself, that He is full of the Holy Spirt. He is promising that since He is full of the Holy Spirit He will now bring relief and rescue to some very specific groups. He is promising to bring the gospel to the poor, healing to the brokenhearted, liberty to captives, recovery of sight to the blind, and liberty to the oppressed. All of this is possible simply because the anointing is present. In fact, you can count on this; wherever the anointing is, change happens; freedom happens. In this season of revival, we need His anointing. We need His Holy Spirit more than ever before. May we continually cry out for His anointing. Wherever His anointing shows up, yokes are destroyed!
