From Our Pastor

"The Fate of our Nation Rests with Us!"

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no vision, people perish.

I am so excited watching what God is doing in our church in the lives of our people. I have been in full-time ministry twenty-seven out of the last 30 years and I don't remember ever seeing anything like this. God is keeping every promise and is guiding us to the thing He called us to as a church and as individuals. He is so FAITHFUL! At the beginning of the year, I try to lay out a vision that I believe God has given me for the year. The reason I do that is simple—His Word encourages vision. Proverbs 29:18 says "Where there is no vision, people perish." In years past, I often refered back to this vision to assure that I was staying the course. This year is no different.

As I look at the vision for 2021, a few things stand out about this year. I believe God is calling His church back to some amazing stuff. I believe that we have all learned that neither church or Jesus can be optional for us. I believe He has reminded us of at least four very important things this year, and I believe we are growing in deep, deep ways. The following list is a reminder of the things I believe He has shown us this year:

1. We have acknowledged that we were trusting in the wrong provisions.

Psalm 20:7 "Some trust in chariots/horses; we trust the name of the Lord."

2. We have acknowledged that we must bring pure worship.

Malachi 1:7-8 By offering polluted food...blind animals in sacrifice, is that not wrong?"

3. We have put on our armor and learned to battle in the heavenly realms.

Ephesians 6:12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood..."

4. We have learned to walk in "Kingdom Principles."
