From Our Pastor

"Finding Favor"

Daniel 1:17-21. As for these four young men, God gave them knowledge and skill in all literature and wisdom; and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams. ¹⁸ Now at the end of the days, when the king had said that they should be brought in, the chief of the eunuchs brought them in before Nebuchadnezzar. ¹⁹ Then the king interviewed them, and among them all none was found like Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah; therefore they served before the king. ²⁰ And in all matters of wisdom and understanding about which the king examined them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers who were in all his realm. ²¹ Thus Daniel continued until the first year of King Cyrus.

So, let's get this story straight. Daniel (probably 16 or 17 years old at the time) was taken captive into a foreign land by a foreign king who was known for his cruelty. He was taken into that foreign land for the purpose of brainwashing. In this foreign land, he had no adult support. His parents weren't there to encourage him. His youth group buddies were not there. His preacher wasn't with him. In short, he was on his own. If he was going to stand strong in the testing of his faith and traditions, he would have to do it alone. This evil king set aside a period of three years to retrain the mindset of this young man and some of the other young men from his country. The king would seek to control every aspect of their lives. He would decide what they could read, what they could eat, and what they could drink. This young man, against all odds, decided that he wouldn't play along. He refused the delicacies of the king and refused to drink the wine apportioned for him. In the process of choosing to not "defile" himself with the portions of the king, this young man gained the respect of even his enemies. Daniel made a choice most of us wouldn't. He chose, even as a kid, to walk by his convictions. Even if it cost him his life, he refused to deny his faith. In doing so, he not only found the favor of God; but he also found the favor of his enemies.

I think this story is a reminder to us of the power and might of our God. He is calling us all to do as Daniel did. He is calling us to great courage and resolve. He is reminding us of this:

- Those who live by their convictions will walk in a new level of understanding.
- Those who live by their convictions will alter even the lives of the lost.
- Those who live by their convictions will walk in a new anointing.
- Those who live by their convictions will see promotion.
