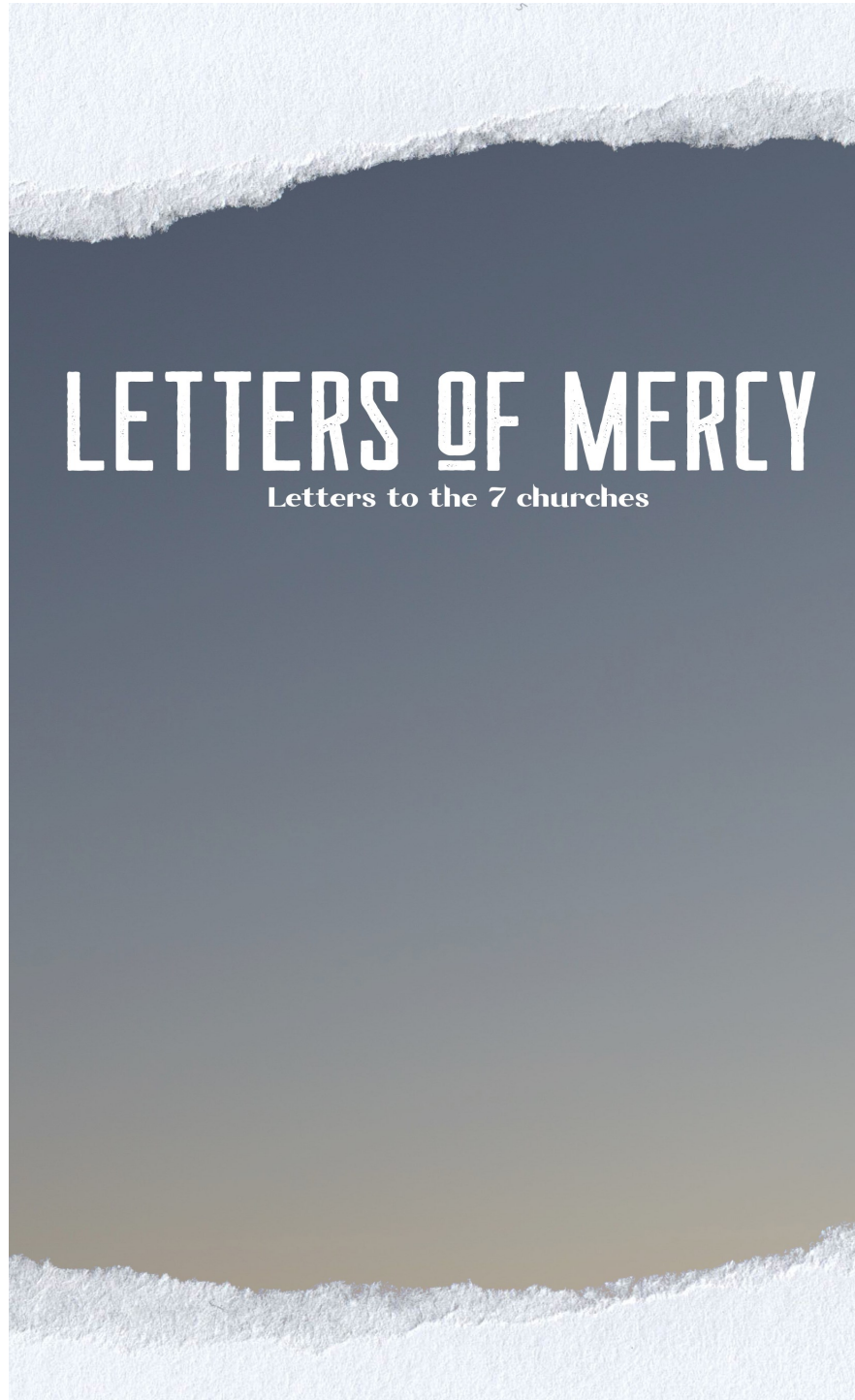

Twice Born!

Rev. 2:10-11 *"Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life."*
11 *"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death."*

I read a quote once that goes like this: "If we are born just once, we die twice; but if we are born twice, we die only once." What does that mean in laymen's terms? Let me try to explain it so we can all understand it.

You see, in scripture, when we hear of a second death; that is a reference to a death that leads to eternal judgment. In other words, the first death is one that is physical and is one we will all face if the Lord tarries. The second death warned of in scripture is a spiritual one. The first death is a separation of the soul and spirit from the body. The second death is a separation of the soul and the spirit from God. There is only one way to avoid facing a "second" death, being born again. Once we come into a relationship with Jesus by faith, we no longer fear a second death. When we die that first death, we are immediately taken into the presence of God for eternity. For us, death is swallowed up in the victory of Jesus over death and the grave. Interestingly enough, the Bible also speaks of two births. The first is physical and the second is spiritual, which we know as being born again. Birth is being "joined to." Death is being "separated from." When a person is born physically, that person's body is joined to a soul and spirit. When that person is born again, that person's soul and spirit are joined to God. Thus, if we are born just once; we die twice. But if we are born twice, we die only once! Isn't that some amazing news!
