




## From Our Tastor

# "Little" Strength

Rev. 3:7-8 "And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write, 'These things says He who is holy, He who is true, "He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens": <sup>8</sup> "I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My word, and have not denied My name.

As Jesus is addressing the church at Philadelphia, we are hard-pressed to find a single negative word in all that He is saying. That's true except for two simple little words right smack in the middle of the letter. These two words have confused me for as long as I've read them. He says to them, "I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have little strength..." Did you catch it? He's complimenting their works and then says to them, but you have little strength. This seems very confusing to me. It would seem to me that if he is commending their efforts, He would commend their "big" strength, not their "little" strength. Then it dawned on me; maybe I am reading it wrong.

Maybe He is saying something different from what I'm perceiving. Maybe He isn't saying that they are weak at all. He may be bragging on them for having strength in the little things. Perhaps He is proud of them because they have shown faithfulness in the way they love in small and personal ways. Maybe His excitement over them and blessing to them stems from the way they love others when no one else is looking. It may be the little things that move the heart of the Father. Perhaps we are sidetracked thinking that what we do only counts when we move big mountains for God. What if we dared to believe that what really impresses the heart of our Father is our faithfulness in the moving of the small mountains. Maybe what impresses His heart is us loving in little ways and serving in little ways. Perhaps He is trying to remind us to love little people in big ways. Maybe "little strength" is what we should all be after.
