

## #FamilyDiscipleship Resurrection Sunday

*During this time that we are unable to meet, we honestly feel like this time is going to strengthen the church, by strengthening our families spiritually! Please be intentional about getting this time together and Diving Deeper together.*

Ideas for discussion:

Read this Scripture and discuss:

*1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (NKJV) For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; <sup>24</sup> and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.” <sup>25</sup> In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.”<sup>26</sup> For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death till He comes. (referencing the gospels: Matt. 26, Mark 14, Luke 22)*

- Communion: Jesus met with the disciples at the “LAST SUPPER” to explain in the natural what He was about to do in the SPIRITUAL.
  - Communion was never meant to be only a ritual or a routine.
  - We are to remember, but it isn’t just about looking back.
  - Natural obedience brings spiritual outpouring. (Ex. We praise; He comes.)

Broken Body of Christ – What does it mean to have His body broken for me?

- By His Stripes I am healed...
- Because He came I am free...

*Isaiah 53:4-6 (NKJV) Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed. <sup>6</sup> All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.*

The Blood of Jesus – Why was the shedding of blood necessary?

- We are washed by the blood and made clean.
- The curse is broken and the debt paid!
- His blood redeemed, ransomed, and restores.
- Justification – just as if I didn’t
- In Christ, we are under the blood.
